In this presentation there is some of the greatest understanding of the human mind: Eli Siegel's comprehension of the turmoil of Robert Southey (1774-1843). And there is an honoring of the beauty and true power of unions.

More than ever, people are concerned about the ethical matters that Mr. Siegel shows are central in this play: the relation of wealth and poverty; labor and profit; what are the rights of people?; "*What does a person deserve by being a person?*"
